INVOC welcomes you to our brand new map of Kings Golf course for the sixth and final Northern Night Cup in 2025. Many thanks to the Kings Golf Club committee for permission to use the area.

Terrain: Kings Golf Club course is a 18-hole Championship Golf Course established in 2019. Stretching over a large area with some small trees and shrubs, noticeable are several water features including streams and three ponds. The course has long straight fairways and some very steep bunkers in places. Greens are OOB to keep runners away from steep bunkers, please follow this. The far part of the course slopes up to the 12th hole which overlooks Inverness City. There is some unmarked low-lying blue fencing present, these are temporary, please look out for them and take care when crossing. The long course will take in the adjacent area of Torvean Park, which is reached by underpath, where a compulsory crossing will be in place.

Maps: Brand new map by Jon Hollingdale in January 2025. Magnetic north pre-marked and printed on waterproof paper, scale 1:4,000 with 2.0m contour intervals.

- All competitors to carry a backup head torch and whistle. A mobile phone is advised.
- Dress appropriately for the weather.
- Under 14s (on the day) must be shadowed by an adult, unless they have prior consent of the organizer.
- You MUST report to Download by Course Closing Time, even if you have not completed the course.
- Competitors are advised to notify the Organiser of any relevant medical conditions.
- First aid is located at registration. The nearest hospital is Raigmore in Inverness.

Parking/registration/start/finish:

- Parking and registration will be at Kings Golf club house, Balphadrig Road, Inverness IV3 8AX.
- Registration is open from 17:45 - 18:45. Starts from 18:00-19:00
- Courses close at 20:00. If you think you will need more than an hour, please start close to 18:00.
- Everyone must register and collect their map.

Toilets: There are toilets in the club house. Please remove shoes before entering the facility.

Courses: Long 5.4km ; Short 3.5km; Night Novice 2.4km. Long and short meet NNC guidelines.
